



Career Assess and Learn (CAL) Program FAQ's

- Days/Times:
 - Each Session is 4 Days from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm
 - The first hour on Day 1 is a Program Overview for Consumers and Their Families
 - Can be done on 4 consecutive Saturdays or any other 4-day period in the afternoons
 - Can be offered as frequently as once per month depending on referrals
- Number of Consumers:
 - Minimum of 4 Consumers Per Session
 - Maximum of 6 Consumers Per Session
- Characteristics of Consumers:
 - College-Bound
 - Average or Higher Intellectual Functioning
 - Must be willing and able to test independently and attend to group instruction, with minimal disruption to the group, for short periods of time over 4 days, without the use of a dedicated paraprofessional or aide.
 - While basic instructional, physical, or testing related accommodations will be made, this is a group service which means that extensive and/or constant 1 on 1 assistance/supervision is not possible.

 - Full TWC Vocational Assessment with Multiple SOC Code Recommendations
 - Exploring You in Work VAT Module
- Domains Assessed:
 - Cognitive Abilities (IQ)
 - Academic Achievement in Reading, Writing, Spelling, and Math (by Grade Level)
 - Physical Abilities (Fine/Gross Motor)
 - Sensory Abilities (Preferred Learning Style)
 - Vocational Interests, Abilities, Values, and Aptitudes
 - Behavioral Observations and Work Habits
 - Executive Functioning Skills
 - Independent Living Skills
 - Medical, Psychological, Educational, Employment, and Social History
